

## City Council Meeting

June 10, 2013

The regular Riverdale City Council meeting of June 10, 2013 was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Schulz.

Present: Marc Schulz, Nita Anderson, Nancy Elliott and Auditor Del Kolke

Absent: Ken Skuza

Elliott moved to approve May 13, 2013 regular meeting minutes, special meeting minutes of May 14, 2013 and Board of Equalization minutes of May 14, 2013 and May 20, 2013. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Anderson moved to approve the bills. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

Elliott moved to approve the agenda as amended. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Guest:

Mr. Bill Radio, Member and Public Relations Director from Missouri River Energy Services (MRES), highlighted possible options for Riverdale's municipal electric utility. Current Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) contract is in effect through 2020 and MRES Supplemental Power contract is through 2046.

Reports:

Chief Haraseth will consult state fire marshall regarding sprinkler system specs provided by a contractor on behalf of Riverdale High Lodge.

Auditor reported annual inspection for overlook was completed by the Corps of Engineers with no deficiencies reported. Due to the July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday, the landfill schedule may be changed. City will provide dirt to resident to repair ruts caused by utility work. Brothers Smoked BBQ submitted May payment for three (3) days of operation.

Old Business:

Anderson moved to approve the 2014 Police Service Contract with McLean Co. Sheriff's Dept. will an annual cost of \$19,983.71 beginning January 1, 2014. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

Elliott moved to allow Brannon Ulmer to sell fireworks within city limits as proposed. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Anderson moved to lift parking ban on Missouri Drive. Motion died for lack of a second.

Elliott moved to levy a special assessment for mowing on Block 3 Lot 14 Madison Addition for 2012. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Portfolio Reports:

Schulz continues to work on updating ordinances. Elliott moved to solicit proposals for Plaza Building II roof repair/replacement and authorize costs to not exceed \$75,000 for emergency awarding of job. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Anderson reported several lots in Morning Star Campground were mowed by city personnel.

Elliott requested the minutes reflect a Cease and Desist Order was not issued by her to Mike McCleery.
