

City Council Meeting

June 9, 2014

The regular Riverdale City Council meeting of June 9, 2014 was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Skuza.

Present: Ken Skuza, Marc Schulz, Nancy Elliott and Auditor Del Kolke

Absent: Nita Anderson

Elliott moved to approve the May 13, 2014 regular meeting minutes and Board of Equalization minutes of May 13, 2014. Schulz seconded. Motion carried.

Schulz moved to approve the bills. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

Elliott moved to approve the agenda as amended. Schulz seconded. Motion carried.

Guest:

Cordel Backman presented electrical service proposal for John Adams Addition. Schulz moved the City of Riverdale grant conditional approval for John Adams Association, Cordel Backman, chairman, to install an underground power line along with necessary transformers from an existing power line on 10th Street, along the north boundary of Walnut Drive to Elm Street. In addition, the John Adams Association has conditional approval to install secondary power distribution lines within the boundaries of Adams Drive. Such approval is conditional upon the City approving the electrical contractor and construction specifications and drawings. John Adams Association will also provide post construction as built drawings for City records. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

Reports:

Fire Dept. has purchased and taken delivery of 2001 Ford F550 4X4 truck which newly acquired sprayer will be mounted to.

Auditor reported Corps of Engineers conducted the annual inspection of overlook and no deficiencies were reported. The landfill will be open Saturday, July 12th rather than July 5th due to Fourth of July holiday. All property owners were notified of mowing requirements. Spraying of city property will be arranged with S & M Lawn Service.

New Business:

Schulz resolved to set city auditor bond at \$500,000 as required by NDCC 40-13-02. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

Portfolio Reports:

Skuza is interested in the city purchasing a sprayer unit for maintenance to spray isolated areas for noxious weeds. City property to the east of water treatment facility may be an option for future water tower.

Schulz indicated relocation and planting of trees in campground area will be scheduled for early October. Agreement with Nathan McCleery regarding outstanding invoice for Sakakawea Sunset Lodge has not been signed and returned.

Elliott has evaluated breaker boxes in Plaza I with Electrical Services for upgrade. The state electrical inspector will be consulted prior to scheduling of work. Installation of additional street lights in several areas of town will be pursued.
