

City Council Meeting

November 12, 2013

The regular Riverdale City Council meeting of November 12, 2013 was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Skuza.

Present: Ken Skuza, Marc Schulz, Nita Anderson, Nancy Elliott and Auditor Del Kolke

Elliott moved to approve the October 14, 2013 meeting minutes. Schulz seconded. Motion carried.

Schulz moved to approve the bills. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

Anderson moved to approve the agenda as amended. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

Reports:

On behalf of Planning & Zoning, Schulz reported attorney is reviewing the options for combining adjacent residential lots to comply with building restrictions.

Fire Dept. was awarded a 50/50 grant through the ND Forest Service.

Old Business:

Schulz moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance No. 44 which addresses unauthorized camping on public or private property. Elliott seconded. Roll Call: Schulz aye, Anderson aye, Elliott aye. Motion carried.

Work continues on Planning & Zoning ordinances. Auditor has updated the zoning map to reflect proposed zoning districts.

Portfolio Reports:

Skuza indicated city maintenance has completed drainage ditch restoration on Dakota Avenue. Area between Morning Star Campground and Missouri Drive has been mowed and trees for removal will be marked in preparation for fall burn. Signs will be placed on city property indicating no hunting is allowed in the campground and golf course area.

Anderson has updated campground rules for 2014 and auditor has calculated utility surcharge based on 2013 water and electrical consumption. Beaver damage and erosion at the Kiddie Pond were discussed.

Elliott reported Missouri River Energy Services completed the scanning of the City's electrical distribution system and determined the system to be in good shape at this time.
