

## City Council Meeting

November 5, 2012

The regular Riverdale City Council meeting of November 5, 2012 was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Skuza.

Present: Ken Skuza, Marc Schulz, Jim Dempsey, Nita Anderson, Nancy Elliott and Auditor Del Kolke

Elliott moved to approve budget hearing minutes and regular meeting minutes of October 8, 2012. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Elliott moved to approve the bills. Schulz seconded. Motion carried.

Dempsey moved to approve the agenda. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Tyler Demars, McLean County Vision West Planning member, presented an outline of community and economic development strategies and quality of life initiatives prepared by Vision West ND. Communities in the county are encouraged to join this coalition to prepare for future needs.

Old Business:

Dempsey moved to accept waste collection proposal from Circle Sanitation for a 5-year period beginning January 1, 2013 – December 31, 2017. Schulz seconded. Motion carried.

New Business:

Schulz moved for the city to charge residents and businesses the same garbage rates Circle Sanitation will assess the city as stated in the approved agreement beginning January 1, 2013. Dempsey seconded. Motion carried.

The church parking lot will be included in the city's snow removal schedule as recommended by council member Dempsey.

The Riverdale Ambulance Service lease for a portion of the Emergency Services Building expires December 31, 2012 with an option to renew the lease for an additional three (3) years. A request from the ambulance service is required to exercise this option.

Schulz moved to execute Contract No. 12-UGPR-1002 between the City of Riverdale and Western Area Power Administration to provide electric service to Riverdale through December 31, 2050. Dempsey seconded. Motion carried.

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Portfolio Reports:

Dempsey indicated maintenance personnel have completed preparations for upcoming winter season.

Anderson proposed minor changes to Morning Star Campground Rules for 2013. Council agreed to recommendations.

Elliott explained the city is not pursuing the sale of the electrical system at this time due to contract limitations. Contact will be made with Border States Electrical to evaluate 13.8kv line and order required parts. Coal Creek Construction will provide installation services.
