

City Council Meeting

December 11, 2013

The regular Riverdale City Council meeting of December 11, 2013 was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Skuza.

Present: Ken Skuza, Marc Schulz, Nita Anderson and Auditor Del Kolke

Absent: Nancy Elliott

Schulz moved to approve the November 12, 2013 meeting minutes. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Anderson moved to approve the bills. Schulz seconded. Motion carried.

Schulz moved to approve the agenda. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Reports:

Planning & Zoning issued nine (9) building permits for 2013 with a total value of \$330,000. Building permit fees collected were \$847.50. City attorney recommends including requirements for combining adjacent lots and splitting lots to be included in P & Z ordinances.

Fire Dept. grant funds will be applied to the purchase of a tornado remote-controlled sprayer which was recently ordered. One new member has joined the department.

City hall will be closed Wednesday, Dec. 25 and Wednesday, Jan. 1.

New Business:

Schulz moved to approve the Joint Election Agreement with McLean County from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Schulz moved to purchase Cimline Melter Model 230DH from Swanston Equipment at a quoted price of \$51,267. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Schulz moved to transfer \$80,000 from Campground Enterprise Fund to General Fund. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Portfolio Reports:

Skuza granted permission to a resident to trap coyotes. An invoice for ditch restoration was sent to Mr. Bertsch.

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Schulz reported Wade Mann will no longer serve as city attorney. Other legal counsel within Crowley Fleck will be assigned.

Anderson indicated auditor will begin sending out campground registrations for 2014.
