Cheatley moved to include start date of January 1, 2019 to salon lease. Taylor seconded. Motion carried.

New Business:

NDCC 54-10-14 allows a city with less than five hundred (500) population to submit an annual financial report to the State Auditor's office in lieu of an out-sourced firm conducting an audit. Auditor will research agencies available to conduct an independent audit and costs.

Cheatley moved to appoint Garth Zimbelman as Missouri River Energy Services representative with Ken Skuza remaining as alternate. Taylor seconded. Motion carried.

Planning & Zoning is urged to finalize updating ordinances and zoning map.

City hall will be closed Feb. 4-8.

Cheatley reported continuing problems with pump no. 1 at the water treatment facility. Filtration membranes are requiring more fiber repair as they age.
