

City Council Meeting
July 9, 2018

The regular Riverdale City Council meeting of July 9, 2018 was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Skuza.

Present: Ken Skuza, Jerry Orth, Craig Richardson, Dick Cheatley, Jonna Taylor and Auditor Del Kolke

Richardson moved to approve the June 11, 2018 regular meeting minutes and special meeting minutes of June 26, 2018. Cheatley seconded. Motion carried.

Orth moved to approve the bills. Taylor seconded. Motion carried.

Cheatley moved to approve the agenda. Orth seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Cheatley moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance No. 47 which amends the alcohol licenses in the City of Riverdale. On sale beer, wine and sparkling wine is changed to OFF sale beer, wine and sparkling wine. Orth seconded. Roll Call: Orth aye, Richardson aye, Taylor aye, Cheatley aye. Motion carried.

Cheatley moved to approve the 2019 Police Service Contract with McLean Co. Sheriff's Dept. at an annual cost of \$13,805.18. Richardson seconded. Motion carried.

Resident's Comments:

Richard & Karen Ghering, 313 8th St.; along with building inspector, Alex Taylor; presented a proposal for garage construction. Orth moved to approve four (4) foot front variance based on building inspector's recommendation. Taylor seconded. Motion carried.

Terry Morast, campground manager, reported minimal tree damage at the campground from June 28th wind storm.

New Business:

Richardson moved to change regular monthly city council meeting time from 7:00PM to **6:00PM** beginning with August meeting. Orth seconded. Motion carried.

Orth moved to increase Kevin Weisz's wage \$1.00/hour retroactive to end of 6-month probation period. Richardson seconded. Motion carried. Cheatley moved to increase Del Kolke and Clay Kruger's wages by 3%. Orth seconded. Motion carried.

Reports:

Auditor has begun insurance claim paperwork for evergreen tree that fell on Plaza II building roof during June 28th storm event.

Skuza reported a large portion of a cottonwood tree is obstructing the road on the south side of the Kiddie Pond. Roger Keller will remove for \$500.

Taylor will meet with maintenance personnel to become informed on electrical portfolio and issues needing to be addressed.
