

City Council Meeting  
June 11, 2018

The regular Riverdale City Council meeting of June 11, 2018 was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Sorensen.

Present: Charles Sorensen, Jerry Orth, Ken Skuza, Dick Cheatley and Auditor Del Kolke

Absent: Craig Richardson

Orth moved to approve the May 14, 2018 meeting minutes. Skuza seconded. Motion carried.

Orth moved to approve the bills. Cheatley seconded. Motion carried.

Orth moved to approve the agenda as amended. Cheatley seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Skuza moved to remove 2-yard dumpster from Plaza II building and issue garbage totes to businesses. Orth seconded. Motion carried.

Police contract was tabled.

Orth moved to amend on sale beer, wine and sparkling wine alcohol license currently held by Sakakawea Enterprises Inc. dba Iron Oar Grill and Pub to OFF sale beer, wine and sparkling wine alcohol license with required ordinance amendment procedure followed. Cheatley seconded.

Roll Call: Orth aye, Skuza nay, Cheatley aye. Motion carried.

Residents Comments:

Jeri Heiser, representing Ashley & Harley Frederick of 308 7<sup>th</sup> Street, requested removal of an electrical guy wire in the way of proposed garage construction. Further information will be gathered.

New Business:

Cheatley moved to set city auditor bond at \$650,000 as required by NDCC 40-13-02. Skuza seconded. Motion carried.

Skuza moved to approve three (3) raffle permits to the Riverdale Ambulance Service with the drawings to be held at the annual fundraiser on July 7, 2018. Cheatley seconded. Motion carried.

Orth moved to allow Brannon Ulmer to sell fireworks at Bayside Marine from June 27, 2018 through July 5, 2018 as directed by North Dakota guidelines. Cheatley seconded. Motion carried.

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Reports:

Organizational meeting of the city council will be held Tuesday, June 26 to install newly elected officials and address any necessary business items.

Sorensen expressed thanks to council members for their service to the City of Riverdale and council extended appreciation to the mayor as well.

AJ Tuck, Ulteig Engineers, presented four (4) options for sanitary sewer improvements on main line to lagoons ranging from complete replacement to partial replacement. Council prefers Option D which addresses only portions requiring immediate attention with a price of \$338,904.55. Contract to proceed will be drafted. Orth moved to have Ulteig perform a street assessment not to exceed \$5,000. Skuza seconded. Motion carried.
