

## City Council Meeting

June 8, 2015

The regular Riverdale City Council meeting of June 8, 2015 was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Sorensen.

Present: Charles Sorensen, Lee Bertsch, Ken Skuza, Nita Anderson, Nancy Elliott and Auditor Del Kolke

Anderson moved to approve the May 11, 2015 meeting minutes. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

Anderson moved to approve the bills. Skuza seconded. Motion carried.

Elliott moved to approve the agenda. Skuza seconded. Motion carried.

### Reports:

Auditor attended a Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan county meeting to assist in updating existing plan. Enforcement of extended street parking will be addressed by county law enforcement. Due to Fourth of July holiday, landfill will be open Saturday, July 11<sup>th</sup> rather than July 4<sup>th</sup>. City hall will be closed June 23 and July 3.

### Old Business:

Bertsch moved to accept the hay bid of \$2,625 per year for a period of three (3) years from Dave Faulkner, Ruso ND. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

No draft of liquor license revision was pursued. Anderson moved to table. Skuza seconded.

Roll Call: Bertsch aye, Skuza aye, Anderson aye, Elliott aye. Motion carried.

Community Church representatives reported their congregation cannot commit to ownership of Plaza I building at this time.

Interstate Engineering was asked to provide work specs on waterline project in Lincoln Addition prior to further action.

### New Business:

Skuza moved to allow Brannon Ulmer to sell fireworks at Bayside Marine from June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015 through July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015 as directed by North Dakota guidelines. Anderson seconded. Motion carried.

Anderson moved to set city auditor bond at \$500,000 as required by NDCC 40-13-02. Elliott seconded. Motion carried.

Portfolio Reports:

Sorensen will pursue obtaining a radar speed sign from ND Dept. of Transportation to bring driver's attention to speeds driven in excess of posted limit on Missouri Drive, Iowa Avenue and Dakota Avenue.

Anderson moved to authorize \$620 from Restaurant/Lodging Special Revenue Fund and Occupancy Special Revenue Fund to the Riverdale Ambulance Service for Todd Mitchell, KFYZ Kafe', to promote Riverdale Ambulance fundraiser and City of Riverdale on Friday, June 19 from 3:00 – 5:00 at the Knights Bar & Grill. Bertsch seconded. Motion carried. Bertsch also requested the formation of a Visitor's Committee to serve as an advisory board to the council on administering the proceeds of occupancy and restaurant/lodging taxes as required by Ordinance No. 40. The implementation of a city sales tax was also suggested by Bertsch.

Skuzza attended McLean County Board of Equalization meeting. Riverdale property values, as reduced by Riverdale Board of Equalization, were not accepted due to state compliance and assessor's original values were approved.
