

City Council Meeting
November 13, 2018

The regular Riverdale City Council meeting of November 13, 2018 was called to order at 6:00 PM by Mayor Skuza.

Present: Ken Skuza, Jerry Orth, Dick Cheatley, Jonna Taylor and Auditor Del Kolke

Cheatley moved to approve the Oct. 8, 2018 meeting minutes. Orth seconded. Motion carried.

Orth moved to approve the bills. Cheatley seconded. Motion carried.

Taylor moved to approve the agenda. Cheatley seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Cheatley moved to appoint Garth Zimbelman to fill the unexpired term left by the resignation of Craig Richardson. Taylor seconded. Motion carried. Zimbelman took his seat at the council table.

New Business:

Taylor moved to sell Lot 20R Block 3 John Adams Addition for \$12,000 to Wyatt Eisenbraun and Lot 21R Block 3 John Adams Addition for \$12,000 to Wayne Hipp. Cheatley seconded. Motion carried.

Auditor provided campground rate information and also proposed utility rate increases, based on the recent rate study, for council consideration. Determination of rates will be made at the December meeting.

Reports:

Skuza reported approximately 480' of 12" sewer pipe remaining from sewer project has been placed in storage. Storm sewer behind Game & Fish has been repaired and second manhole has been located and is in good condition and working properly.

Taylor, on behalf of Riverdale Women's Club, asked about the use of the former credit union space for the Christmas tree lighting scheduled for Dec. 2. Club members will clean space prior to event. No objections from council.
